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

 Provide an overview of family maintenance systems as a key domain of ongoing family life with potential to contribute to both family competence and resilience


- Identify domains of family maintenance

## Family Resilience Model




## Family Adaptive Systems

## Implications for Family Life Education

- Research
  - Better understanding the development and regulation of family maintenance functions

- Marriage Enrichment and Family Intervention
  - Improving the maintenance system's functioning to advance effectiveness of therapeutic work
  - Improving service provision through systematic identification of resources utilized by maintenance system

#### Conclusions

 Awareness of the maintenance system can aid FLEs in preventing and minimizing problems that may be the result of a poorly functioning maintenance system

Broader Impacts: Prevention and Intervention

 Help families meet basic needs regardless of circumstance by promoting healthy family functioning within maintenance system
