*Family Relations: Interdisciplinary Journal of Applied Family Science* publishes articles that are original, innovative, interdisciplinary, or translational. Articles focus on diverse families and family issues.

Appropriate articles include empirically-based applied research; critical syntheses of relevant substantive areas; and reports of systematic program evaluations, practice advances, analyses, and assessments of developed applied or academic curricula.

Family Relations also accepts manuscripts related to professional development in Family Science, as well as manuscripts addressing philosophical underpinnings of the main activities in Family Science (e.g., educating Family Scientists, design and delivery of tools used in practice, and refinement and expansion of research methods).

Family Relations publishes original research and applied practice articles that clearly present new advances in Family Science. In the past year, Family Relations introduced three article formats focused on bringing innovative work that brings new ideas to Family Relations readers.

- Emerging Ideas format focuses on new ideas related to advancing Family Science either the science of discovery or science of practice. The core characteristic of Emerging Ideas Brief Reports is their novelty to Family Science.
- Translating Discovery Family Science manuscripts document meaningful first steps in moving results from discovery science into the science of practice. T
- Lessons from the Field, which is a tool for reporting either problems and barriers
  encountered, or achievements and successes experienced in the application of the
  discipline of Family Science. The primary goal is to share these experiences to advance
  Family Science. Lessons from the Field provides a format for sharing this wisdom for
  testing or generalization to other applications.

A central goal for *Family Relations* is providing information and innovations that directly impact family and practice. Thus, for all submissions, the editorial staff encourage an indication of the implications of the work.
