Instructions for Submitting a Proposal to TCRM

1. All proposals should be submitted electronically to the TCRM co-chairs at tcrm@ncfr.org. Proposals will not be accepted via alternative submission methods.
2. Attach your proposal in the email as a single PDF document:
 - a. **this application form** (including proposed discussants/reviewers);
 - b. **the working paper, symposium, workshop title, or dialogue session name;**
 - c. **a short abstract** (no more than 100 words for publicity purposes);
 - d. **a proposal** (no more than 1,750 words, excluding tables, figures, and references) for peer review; and
 - e. **2 to 3 suggestions for discussants.**
3. **Symposium only:** the submission should also include the symposium title and a brief description of how the papers tie together.
4. Proposals should provide:
 - a. background, context, and significance of the topic proposal;
 - b. connections to the [NCFR conference theme](#);
 - c. relationship to one or more of the four TCRM goals (family theory, research methodology, emerging/novel ideas in the study of families, and/or reconsideration of long-held practices and ideas in Family Science);
 - d. a description of how the paper, symposium, workshop, or dialogue addresses innovative, novel, and/or important issues in theory, methodology, and or the empirical study of families; and
 - e. a brief discussion of the paper, symposium, workshop, or dialogue's implications for research and/or practice. Evidence of work already underway is welcomed and encouraged.
5. The deadline for TCRM submissions is **March 15, 2024, 11:59 p.m. PST**.
 - a. Authors of accepted papers will be required to submit a full version of the paper, up to 35 pages, by **August 19, 2024**.
 - b. Authors will submit an extended abstract (1,000 words) by **October 4, 2024**. The extended abstract is provided in lieu of a formal presentation by the author at the beginning of the session. Sessions will instead begin with the discussant comments followed by author responses and audience feedback.
6. TCRM submitters should complete the TCRM application form and attach the proposal in PDF format.
