In terms of organizational structure and administration, sections originate (and are dissolved) through the action of the NCFR Board of Directors, operating according to the NCFR bylaws. A section of NCFR may be formed when a preliminary statement of purpose/rationale to establish a new section has been filed with the board, and when 150 active NCFR members with a family section-related specialty have registered their intent for board consideration.
